Minister of War Alexander Pavlovich Rodzyanko

Alexander Pavlovich Rodzyanko is the Minister of War for the Russian Republic. As such, he will have the supreme command over Russia's armies and an interest in Russia's weapon development programs. This means that he will be able to move troops, control recruitment and training, and plan and carry out attacks. He also has better means of carrying out assassinations than most characters. He has trained his entire life to fight, has fought, and has overwhelmingly won. As a war hero, he garners popular support from veterans of both the Great and Civil War. But at what cost? Rodzyanko's own homeland of the Ukraine is no longer part of the nation, the traitor Kolchak has seized Vladivostok unchecked, and the oil rich Caucus now calls itself the Don-Kuban Union. Russia's first step of action is to regain its lost territories that are so vital for its survival. The Ukrainian breadbasket, access to the Pacific, and oil fields are crucial for the growth of Russia economically and militarily. At any moment the socialist hordes could attempt to collapse the Russian Republic so it is vital that the nation is prepared to wage a long and bloody war. This likelihood of war is increased by the wide political ideologies within the country. This is why instead of pushing capitalism or socialism the government should pursue nationalism as its rallying point. During this quest, Russia will need allies. These can change with the circumstances, but without aid, the Germans could choose to crush the still young Republic. Rodzyanko's role in the cabinet is to be a defender of the nation. However, as any general knows, sometimes the best defense is an overwhelming offensive.

At the onset of the conference, the Transamurian Admiralty will be annihilated and Admiral Kolchak will hang. Rodzyanko and the Republic must show both their people and the outside world that treason will never be tolerated. Involving Minister of the Navy Mikhail Alexandrovich Kedrov will be essential in this action as well as German aid if Japan interferes. Following this action, Rodzyanko will push for the holding of "elections" in former Asiatic territories such as the Don-Kuban Union.
